- Postgraduate degree in Environmental Design, Architectural Engineering, or a related field.
- Professional experience within an architecture or engineering practice (preferred).
- Strong grasp of building physics and environmental analysis software.

Professional Skills

- Exceptional organisational, problem-solving, and time-management skills.
- Proactive and collaborative attitude with a passion for engaging internal and external teams.
- Confident communicator, able to present complex environmental strategies across various formats.

Industry Knowledge

- Familiarity with UK design stages (RIBA) and building regulations.
- Knowledge of key sustainability initiatives, such as the RIBA 2030 Climate Challenge and LETI.
- Understanding of certification frameworks, including BREEAM, WELL, Passivhaus, LEED, and NABERS.

Technical Knowledge

- Demonstrable knowledge of environmental analysis, including energy, daylighting, thermal comfort (overheating), PHPP modelling, and Life Cycle Assessment (LCA).
- Knowledge of simulation tools and contemporary HVAC engineering technologies.
- Software Proficiency: Revit, Rhino, and Grasshopper (specifically Ladybug and Honeybee); skilled in PHPP, IES VE, and One Click LCA.
