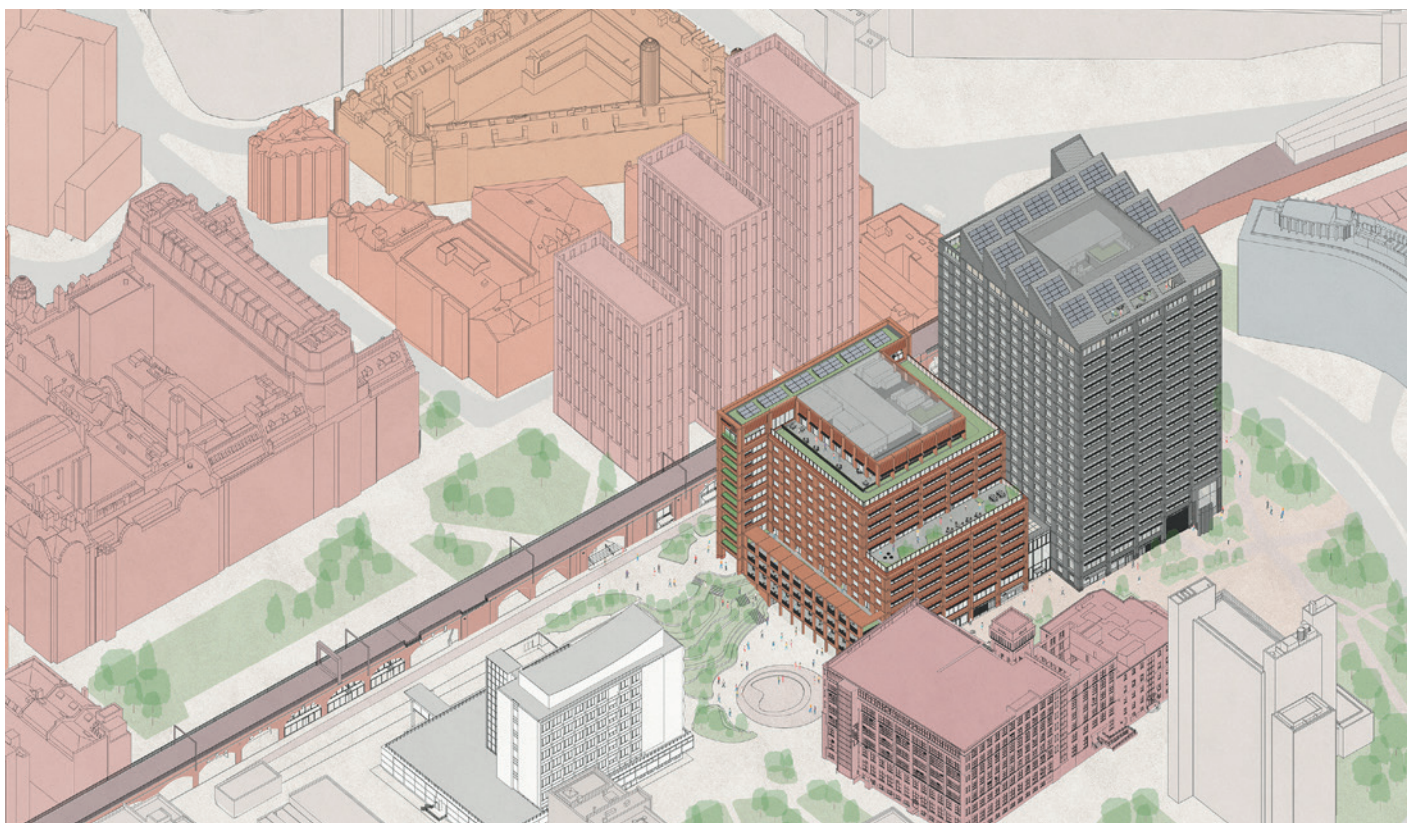


planning approval: **Plot C, Sister, Manchester**

Two linked commercial buildings on the north-east corner of the Sister campus have received planning consent from Manchester City Council.

Hayden French, Director and Head of Workplace, at Allies and Morrison said “Sister Plot C receiving planning consent is an important moment to celebrate, and a vote of confidence in Allies and Morrison’s proposals for Sister - Manchester’s new innovation district. As the first major new-build phase of our masterplan, Plot C is an exciting signal of things to come.

“Plot C will be one of the city’s largest new workplace-led developments set within extensive landscaping, public routes and a reimagined public square. Our proposals offer a broad range of workspaces designed to attract a range of start-ups, SMEs and larger enterprises and innovators across a pair of large, interconnected, flexible buildings. The characterful buildings celebrate their Piccadilly gateway location with facades similar in their articulation, but distinct in scale and identity. C1’s warm red tones meet the red brick context of the Whitworth Street Conservation Area, while the taller C2 silhouette stands out as a strong charcoal-grey landmark announcing arrival at the Sister innovation district.”
