

new work: **Trinity College Dublin masterplan**

Following an international selection process, Allies and Morrison has been appointed to develop a future vision for Trinity College Dublin. The masterplan will honour the university's reputation as Ireland's leading university, respect and enhance its built heritage, and facilitate its continual evolution as a flexible, 21st century environment for excellence in teaching and learning, research and innovation.

Trinity has a wide-ranging estate including over 200 buildings, from elegant 18th century courtyards, to 20th century masterpieces, to state-of-the-art modern facilities, across multiple sites. An essential part of the masterplan vision is to maintain world-class teaching and research facilities within this unique estate whilst also supporting the university's 2030 decarbonisation strategy. But it also targets a campus that embodies Trinity's core values; that is more inclusive, that champions climate action and biodiversity, that better engages with the city, and enables its students and staff to thrive.

Our team will work across the entire estate to realise this potential, engaging with students and staff and identifying opportunities for Trinity to use its places and spaces more creatively, sustainably and effectively.

The appointment marks an important milestone in Allies and Morrison's presence in Ireland, where we have a Dublin studio. The practice is also involved in the Town Centre First programme which is helping to revitalise town centres nationally in Ireland. Other projects in the country include new homes, masterplanning and award-winning public realm design.
