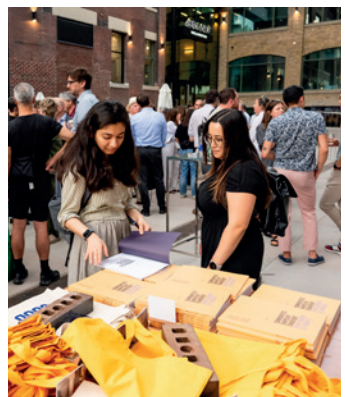
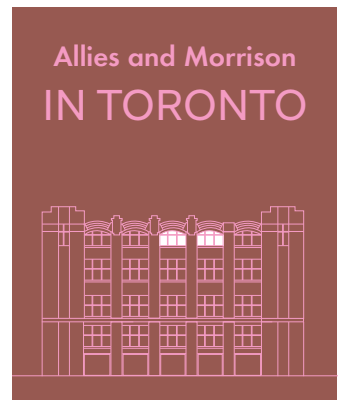


new studio: **Allies and Morrison, Toronto**
